- Students can contact my <u>Salt Lake City District Office</u> at 801-364-5550 to request an application.
- Applications are due by October 14, 2016 in my Salt Lake City District Office.
- Once completed applications are received, students will receive a letter notifying them of their interview time with the Nomination Selection Committee.
- Student interviews with the Nomination Selection Committee will be held in November or December at my <u>Salt Lake City District Office</u>. Students will be contacted individually to set up times to meet with the nominations committee. After completion, the committee submits their recommendations for nominations to me.
- In December, students will receive a letter notifying them if they are receiving a nomination.
- Nominations are submitted by my office to the respective academies by the January 31, 2017 deadline. Once nominations are submitted, it is up to the respective academies to offer an appointment.
- Students who are offered an appointment by the academies are notified sometime during the spring of 2017.
- The deadline for students who have been offered an appointment to accept or decline the offer is May 1,2017.
- Appointees enter their respective academies in July 2017.

Service Academy Nomination 2016 Information Sheet (Class of 2021)

A completed application requires the following items to be submitted to my SLC District Office:

- 1. This application with pages 4-7 answered completely.
- The official results of your Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) and/or your American College Test (ACT).
 Congressional codes are listed in standardized test registration booklets.
- 3. Your High School Transcript.

In addition, to be eligible for consideration you must be:

- 1. A United States citizen (prior to entering the academy).
- 2. Unmarried without dependents and not pregnant.
- 3. Have good moral character.
- 4. Be at least 17 years old and have not passed your 23rd birthday on July 1st of the year you would enter the academy.
- 5. You must be a legal resident of Utah's Second Congressional District. You can confirm which congressional district you're in by going to this link: http://www.house.gov/representatives/find/
