House Republican Policy Committee Planned Parenthood Votes 114th Congress

H.R. 3134, the Defund Planned Parenthood Act (Rep. Diane Black) – <u>Passed 241-187-1</u> September 18, 2015 | Places a one-year moratorium on funding for Planned Parenthood Federation of America and its affiliates, and redirects funds to Community Health Centers.

H.R. 3495, the Women's Public Health and Safety Act (Rep. Sean Duffy) – <u>Passed 236-193</u> September 29, 2015 | Provides States the freedom and flexibility to remove abortion providers from Medicaid.

H.Con.Res. 79, Directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives to make corrections in the enrollment of H.R. 719 (Rep. Martha Roby) – <u>Passed 241-185-1</u> September 30, 2015 | Known as an "enrollment correction", the resolution imposes a one-year moratorium on funding for Planned Parenthood. The text is identical to H.R. 3134.

H.Res. 461, Establishing a Select Investigative Panel of the Committee on Energy and Commerce (Rep. Virginia Foxx) – Passed 242-184 October 7, 2015 | Establishes a select panel within the Energy and Commerce Committee, comprised of 8 Republicans and 6 Democrats appointed by the Speaker, to investigate abortion and fetal tissue procurement.

H.R. 3762, the Restoring Americans' Healthcare Freedom Reconciliation Act (Rep. Tom Price) – <u>Passed 240-189</u> October 23, 2015 | Repeals certain provisions in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and places a one year freeze on certain funding for abortion providers such as Planned Parenthood.
