ABC Skips Own Poll: Record Low for Obamacare

"According to an ABC News/Washington Post poll, support for ObamaCare is at a 'record low' level. Yet, viewers wouldn't know that from watching the network. Journalists on [the June 7th, 2015 telecast of] World News and Good Morning America [the following morning] failed to cover the poll from their own network. According to the Washington Post, 'The survey finds opinion on the health-care law among the worst in Post-ABC polling; 54 percent oppose, up six percentage points from a year ago."
