

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
FOR H.R. 5
OFFERED BY MR. BRIDENSTINE OF OKLAHOMA**

Add at the end the following new section:

1 **SEC. 802. SENSE OF CONGRESS ON THE FEDERAL ROLE IN**
2 **ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION.**

3 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds as follows:

4 (1) Elementary and secondary education is not
5 a power of the Federal Government enumerated in
6 the United States Constitution.

7 (2) Therefore, under the tenth amendment of
8 the United States Constitution, elementary and sec-
9 ondary education is a power reserved for the States.

10 (b) SENSE OF THE CONGRESS.—It is the sense of
11 Congress that when Congress next considers reauthoriza-
12 tion of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of
13 1965, Congress should instead consider legislation to re-
14 peal such Act and eliminate the role of the Federal Gov-
15 ernment in elementary and secondary education.
