

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
FOR H.R. 5
OFFERED BY MR. LAMBORN OF COLORADO**

Page 563, after line 15, insert the following:

1 **“SEC. 6532. SCHOOLCHILDREN’S HEALTH PROTECTION.**

2 “(a) LIMITATIONS ON FUNDING.—Notwithstanding
3 section 6102, no funds under this Act may be used to—

4 “(1) distribute or provide, or permit the dis-
5 tribution or provision of, postcoital emergency con-
6 traception (such as the so-called ‘morning-after
7 pill’), or a prescription for such contraception, on
8 the premises, or in the facilities, of an elementary
9 school or secondary school; or

10 “(2) enter into a contract or other agreement
11 relating to the provision of health services to stu-
12 dents with a school-based health center unless such
13 center agrees that it will not provide postcoital emer-
14 gency contraception, or a prescription for such con-
15 traception, to any such student pursuant to the con-
16 tract or agreement.

17 “(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

18 “(1) The term ‘postcoital emergency contracep-
19 tion’ means—

1 “(A) any of the regimens described in the
2 notice entitled ‘Prescription Drug Products;
3 Certain Combined Oral Contraceptives for Use
4 as Postcoital Emergency Contraception’, pub-
5 lished in the Federal Register on February 25,
6 1997 (62 Fed. Reg. 8610), or any subsequent
7 corresponding notice; or

8 “(B) any other drug or device to be used
9 after fertilization may have occurred and for
10 the same purposes as the regimes in subpara-
11 graph (A).

12 “(2) The term ‘school-based health center’ has
13 the meaning given such term in section 2110(e)(9)
14 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
15 1397jj(e)(9)).”.
