

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
TO H.R. 399
OFFERED BY MR. O’ROURKE OF TEXAS**

After section 12, insert the following new section (and redesignate the subsequent sections, conform any cross references to such subsequent sections, and conform the table of contents in section 1(b), accordingly):

1 SEC. 13. CBP OFFICER FLEXIBILITY.

2 (a) TRANSFER.—The Assistant Commissioner for the
3 Office of Field Operations in U.S. Customs and Border
4 Protection (in this section referred to as the “Assistant
5 Commissioner”) may transfer officers of U.S. Customs
6 and Border Protection, on a voluntary basis, to land ports
7 of entry that experience high vehicular, commercial, and
8 pedestrian volume and long bridge crossing wait times, as
9 determined by the Assistant Commissioner.

10 (b) INCENTIVE BONUS.—At the discretion of the As-
11 sistant Commissioner, an officer of U.S. Customs and
12 Boarder Protection may be eligible for an incentive bonus
13 for any transfer carried out pursuant to subsection (a) if
14 the Assistant Commissioner determines that such transfer
15 is critical to reducing wait times and expediting the legiti-
16 mate flow of goods and people at land ports of entry.

1 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—To carry
2 out this section, there is authorized to be appropriated
3 \$30,000,000 for fiscal year 2016 and each subsequent fis-
4 cal year.
