

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 185
OFFERED BY MR. NADLER OF NEW YORK

Add, at the end of the bill, the following:

1 **SEC. 10. EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN RULES AND GUIDANCE.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 5 of title 5, United
3 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 553a
4 (as inserted by section 4 of this Act) the following new
5 section:

6 **“§ 553b. Exemption for certain rules and guidance**

7 “Sections 551, 553, 556, 701(b), 704, and 706, as
8 amended by the Regulatory Accountability Act of 2015,
9 and section 553a shall not apply in the case of a rule or
10 guidance proposed, made, or issued by the Nuclear Regu-
11 latory Commission pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of
12 1954. Sections 551, 553, 556, 701(b), 704, and 706, as
13 in effect before the enactment of the Regulatory Account-
14 ability Act of 2015, shall apply to such proposed rules,
15 final rules, or guidance, as appropriate.”.

16 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
17 for chapter 5 of title 5, United States Code, is amended

1 by inserting after the item relating to section 553 the fol-

2 lowing new item:

“553b. Exemption for certain rules and guidance.’”.
