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

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

Page 464 – Mark Zuckerman should be listed under the Minority's 3(D) personnel. His annual salary is \$130,000.00 and gross is \$10,833.33.

Page 465 – Brian Kennedy's annual salary should be listed as \$130,000.00, not \$168,000.00. His gross salary should be listed as \$10,833.33, not \$21,666.66. In August, his gross salary of \$10,833.33 was not paid on time by payroll. A paper check was issued on September 3. Since his gross salary was missing from the final August payroll certification and the final Monthly Financial Statement, his salary was handwritten in on both and totals were adjusted accordingly. On September 22, his annual salary was changed to \$168,000.00, effective September 1. Since the payroll deadline for payroll changes is September 15, the difference of \$3,166.67 between his new annual salary of \$168,000.00 and previous annual salary of \$130,000.00 was paid as a supplemental check in October, that amount will appear on the October payroll in addition to his regular monthly salary.
