

The Committee on Energy and Commerce held a markup on Tuesday, February 15, 2011, covering: (1) the Energy and Commerce Committee Oversight Plan for the 112th Congress; (2) H.R. 358, the Protect Life Act, as amended; (3) H.R. 525, the Veterinary Public Health Workforce and Education Act; (4) H.R. 528, the Neglected Infections of Impoverished Americans Act; and, (5) H.R. 570, the Dental Emergency Responder Act. The Oversight Plan was adopted by voice vote. H.R. 525, H.R. 528, and H.R. 570 were adopted by voice vote without amendment. H.R. 358 passed by a roll call vote, 33-19. Amendments to H.R. 358 by Rep. DeGette, Rep. Schakowsky, and Rep. Engel failed by roll call votes of 17-32, 19-31, and 19-31, respectively.

Subcommittee on Commerce, Manufacturing, and Trade

The Subcommittee on Commerce, Manufacturing, and Trade held a hearing on Thursday, February 17, 2011, entitled "A Review of CPSIA and CPSC Resources."

Amendments to H.R. 358 by Waxman, Engel, Schakowsky, Pallone, and Capps failed by roll call votes of 9-16, 9-16, 9-15, 9-15, and 9-14, respectively. An amendment to H.R. 358 by Rep. Baldwin was ruled non germane.

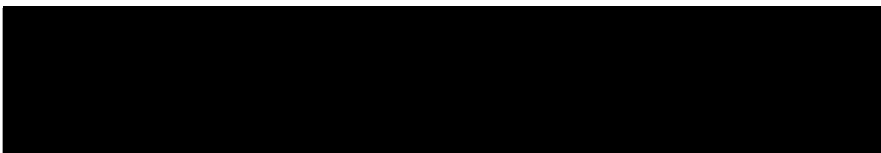
