Dear Secretary Carter,

The Department of Defense is currently the only federal agency that fails to comply with the Chief Financial Officers Act of 1990 which requires Federal agencies to pass an annual audit. The importance and necessity of auditable financial statements within the Department of Defense is an issue that draws broad bipartisan support, and frustration has understandably mounted at the Department's failure to achieve this statute.

However, while much of the Department's audit history is one riddled with half measures and unattained deadlines, in recent years the DoD has made considerable strides toward achieving auditability. Amongst several factors, we have found that these advancements were due to the leadership from the Secretary of Defense. Strong departmental leadership will be essential to capitalizing on the gains made in order to meet the remaining two statutory audit deadlines.

The DoD's Financial Improvement and Audit Readiness (FIAR) Plan states that the DoD shall validate the audit readiness of all financial statements by September 30, 2017, in compliance with law. Upon completion of audit readiness, the Department must audit their FY18 financial books and submit the results to Congress no later than March 31, 2019. The FIAR Plan builds upon years of gradual advances towards full DoD audit, and after several years this plan is now producing positive results. As noted, the auditability progress made thus far is due, in large part, to the priority both Secretary Panetta and Secretary Hagel placed on achieving financial transparency within the DoD. Secretary Panetta first set a 2014 end date for the Statement of Budgetary Resources to be audit ready, which aggressively accelerated the DoD's financial improvement plans, sending a clear signal to the Department that audit is a priority and here to stay. Secretary Hagel recognized audit achievements by the USMC and implemented the Department's Financial Management Certification Program to build institutional knowledge on auditability. With these 2017 and 2019 statutory deadlines fast approaching, momentum must be maintained through continued leadership at the highest levels.

As the new Secretary of the Department of Defense, we respectfully request an outline of how you intend to support the objectives of the FIAR plan and move the Department towards full financial auditability. The Department of Defense has made it too far to lose ground during

transition, and we ask you for reaffirmed leadership and commitment to the Department's financial management and auditability.
