Service Academy Overview

The process of gaining admission to a U.S. service academy begins with obtaining a *nomination*. Students may seek a nomination by submitting an application to their U.S. Representative, their two U.S. Senators and the Vice-President. U.S. Representatives, U.S. Senators and the Vice-President are each allowed to nominate up to ten individuals each year to each of the service academies. Accordingly, this is a highly competitive process. You may also apply to the President for a nomination if you are the child or legally adopted child of a career officer or enlisted personnel of the armed forces and meet other certain conditions.

To be eligible for a nomination, interested applicants must also contact the service academy of their choice and follow its application process. High school students should contact the service academies in the spring of their junior year and apply for a Congressional nomination in the fall of their senior year.

Representative Coffman will select the nominees for the 6th Congressional District after an extensive review of the applications by his office staff and the evaluation of the results of an applicant interview with a screening panel. The decision to make an *appointment* offer (offer of admission) will then be made by the respective academies.

Requirements and qualification standards for the service academies include:

- Citizen of the United States.
- At least 17 years of age, but not yet reached age 23 by July 1st of the year of entry. (Age 25 for the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy)
- Must be unmarried, not pregnant and without legal obligation to support children or other dependents.
- Possess good moral character.
- Be academically competitive.
- Pass a comprehensive medical examination.
- Pass a physical fitness assessment consisting of a kneeling basketball throw, pull-ups/flexed-arm hang, shuttle run, crunches, push-ups and a one-mile run.

Remember, obtaining a nomination to a service academy is only one step in the process. Applicants must also contact the respective academies to inquire about their requirements and application process.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

The applicant must have legal residency within Colorado's 6th Congressional District. Please visit www.house.gov to determine your correct Congressional district.

APPLICATION FORM

Complete, sign and submit this Service Academy Nomination Application form by the deadline.

PERSONAL LETTER

Compose a formal letter to Representative Coffman (no more than one page) describing your desire to attend a U.S. Service Academy and serve in the U.S. military.

TRANSCRIPTS

Have your academic institution send an official transcript directly to Representative Coffman's office. If your ACT/SAT score is present on your transcript, the below step is not necessary. Some transcripts only list one test score, therefore if want us to superscore your results, we must receive each separate test result from the testing institution.

TEST SCORES

Have your testing institution send ACT/SAT scores directly to Representative Coffman's office, if not included on the transcript. Submit multiple reports for superscoring purposes. Please note that tests taken in September will typically not be sent in time for this office's deadline the following month.

THREE RECOMMENDATION FORMS

Identify <u>only three</u> separate adults to complete and submit the Applicant Recommendation Form. Recommendation letters are optional, but the recommendation form is required. Your recommenders must include <u>one math or science teacher</u>, <u>one school staff member</u> and <u>one non-school/community member</u>. The form should be mailed or e-mailed directly to Representative Coffman's Aurora District Office by the recommender.

DEADLINE

Each of the above items must be received in U.S. Representative Mike Coffman's District Office by <u>5:00 PM Mountain Time on Friday</u>, October <u>7</u>, <u>2016</u>. Any applications arriving after this date/time will not be considered.
