We are writing to congratulate and thank you for your hard work towards re-authorizing the Commercial Space Launch Act. While there, we discussed many issues we see as essential for the expansion of the U.S. commercial space sector; a prerequisite to true space development and space settlement.

With the release of the SPACE act, from Majority Leader McCarthy, we are glad to see that the Congress shares our vision, and strongly support its passage in the United States House of Representatives. One of our key issues we discussed during our office visits was extending the learning period, and the inclusion of an 8 year extension is wonderful. Other items, such as allowing license/permit flexibility and encouraging voluntary standards also deserve thanks, as they will enable industry innovation and growth, and helping us to become a true spacefaring society.

We are heartened that the US Congress and the Administration are in sync, since the current US Space Transportation Policy states

"Pursue policy, regulatory, and other measures to foster the development of U.S. commercial spaceflight capabilities serving the emerging nongovernmental human spaceflight market"
