1. UNITED STATES CAPITOL

2. AIR & SPACE MUSEUM

Check out the largest collection of historic aircraft and spacecraft in the world.

3. HOLOCAUST MUSEUM

Soak in the extremely powerful and important exhibit on the atrocities of the holocaust.

4. ARLINGTON CEMETARY

Try to catch one of the hourly Changing of the Guard ceremonies at the tomb of the Unknown Soldier.

5. LINCOLN MEMORIAL

This is Congressman Stewart's favorite memorial on the mall; see it at night if you can.

6. PORTRAIT GALLERY

View portraits of all the presidents and other pivotal figures from American History. The Gallery also contains great modern and classic collections and exhibits.

Hours: 11:30am-7pm

7. ROCKLANDS BBQ

Rocklands is the best BBQ in all of DC. It's a bit of a journey from the hill, but well worth it. Give the Honey Jalapeño Cornbread a try.

8. EVENING PARADE

Reserve seats for the exquisite rifle throwing ceremony at the Washington Marine barracks.
