At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 10. LIMITATION ON IMPLEMENTATION.**

2 Nothing in this Act shall be construed as authorizing
3 climate services and products provided by a National Cli-
4 mate Service or a Climate Service Program at the Na-
5 tional Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to be the
6 basis of, or used as part of, a regulatory regime until such
7 time as a national infrastructure of observing, monitoring,
8 measuring, and verification technologies used to provide
9 such climate services and products has been certified by
10 the National Academy of Sciences as being able to provide
11 accurate and verifiable information at the regional, State,
12 and local level.
