The Committee on Small Business Subcommittee on Health and Technology will meet for a hearing titled, *The Health Insurance Fee: Impact on Small Businesses*. The hearing is scheduled to begin at 10:00 A.M. on May 9, 2013 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.

Under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, an annual fee will be assessed on companies that provide the health insurance policies that most small businesses purchase. A recent study released by the National Federation of Independent Business found that the fee is likely to be passed on to the purchasers of the insurance -- small businesses and their employees — in the form of increased premiums. This hearing will provide an opportunity to examine the economic effects of the fee on small businesses.
