RESOLUTION FROM THE GILA COUNTY DEMOCRATIC PARTY EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE SOUTHEAST ARIZONA LAND EXCHANGE PENDING IN THE U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND U.S. SENATE.
