

## AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3892

## OFFERED BY MR. GOODLATTE OF VIRGINIA

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
2	This Act may be cited as the "Muslim Brotherhood
3	Terrorist Designation Act of 2015".
4	SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS.
5	It is the sense of Congress that—
6	(1) the Muslim Brotherhood meets the criteria
7	for designation as a foreign terrorist organization
8-	under section 219(a)(1) of the Immigration and Na-
9	tionality Act (8 U.S.C. $1189(a)(1)$ ); and
10	(2) the Secretary of State, in consultation with
11	the Secretary of the Treasury and the Secretary of
12	Homeland Security, should exercise the Secretary of
13	State's statutory authority under section 219 of the
14	Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1189) by
15	designating the Muslim Brotherhood as a foreign

1	SEC. 3. REPORT ON DESIGNATION OF THE MUSLIM BROTH-
2	ERHOOD AS A FOREIGN TERRORIST ORGANI-
3	ZATION.
4	(a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
5	(1) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMIT-
6	TEES.—The term "appropriate congressional com-
7	mittees" means—
8	(A) the Committee on Homeland Security
9	and Governmental Affairs of the Senate;
10	(B) the Committee on Armed Services of
11	the Senate;
12	(C) the Committee on Foreign Relations of
13	the Senate;
14	(D) the Select Committee on Intelligence
15	of the Senate;
16	(E) the Committee on the Judiciary of the
17	Senate;
18	(F) the Committee on Banking, Housing,
19	and Urban Affairs of the Senate;
20	(G) the Committee on Homeland Security
21	of the House of Representatives;
22	(H) the Committee on Armed Services of
23	the House of Representatives;
24	(I) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of
25	the House of Representatives:

1	(J) the Permanent Select Committee on
2	Intelligence of the House of Representatives;
3	(K) the Committee on the Judiciary of the
4	House of Representatives; and
5	(L) the Committee on Financial Services
6	of the House of Representatives.
7	(2) Intelligence community.—The term
8	"intelligence community" has the meaning given
9	that term in section 3(4) of the National Security
10	Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3003(4)).
11	(b) REPORT.—Not later than 60 days after the date
12	of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State, in
13	consultation with the intelligence community, shall submit
14	a detailed report to the appropriate congressional commit-
15	tees that—
16	(1) indicates whether the Muslim Brotherhood
17	meets the criteria for designation as a foreign ter-
18	rorist organization under section 219(a)(1) of the
19	Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
20	1189(a)(1));
21	(2) if the Secretary determines that the Muslim
22	Brotherhood does not meet the criteria referred to in
23	paragraph (1), includes a detailed justification as to
24	which criteria have not been met; and

1		(3) if the Secretary determines that the Muslim
2		Brotherhood does meet the criteria referred to in
3		paragraph (1), but does not designate the Muslim
4		Brotherhood as a foreign terrorist organization pur-
5		suant to the Secretary's authority under section 219
6		of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
7		1189), includes a detailed justification as to why the
8	,	Secretary has not so designated the Muslim Brother-
9		hood.
10		(c) FORM.—The report required under subsection (b)
11	shal	l be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
12	a cla	assified annex, if appropriate.
