## A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to require the Administrator of the Small Business Administration to report certain information to the Congress and to the President, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Clarity on Small Busi-  
5 ness Participation in Category Management Act of 2018”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPORTING.**

7 Section 15(h) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.  
8 644(h)) is amended by adding at the end the following:

1           “(4) BEST IN CLASS SMALL BUSINESS PARTICI-  
2           PATION REPORTING.—

3           “(A) ADDENDUM.—The Administrator, in  
4           addition to the requirements under paragraph  
5           (1), shall include in the report required by such  
6           paragraph, for each best in class designation—

7                   “(i) the total amount of spending gov-  
8                   ernment wide in such designation;

9                   “(ii) the dollar amount of contracts  
10                  within such category awarded to each of  
11                  the following—

12                           “(I) HUBZone small business  
13                           concerns;

14                           “(II) small business concerns  
15                           owned and controlled by women;

16                           “(III) small business concerns  
17                           owned and controlled by service-dis-  
18                           abled veterans; and

19                           “(IV) socially and economically  
20                           disadvantaged small business con-  
21                           cerns.

22           “(B) BEST IN CLASS.—The term ‘best in  
23           class’ has the meaning given to it by the Direc-  
24           tor of the Office of Management and Budget.”.
