RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (S. 139) to implement the use of Rapid DNA instruments to inform decisions about pretrial release or detention and their conditions, to solve and prevent violent crimes and other crimes, to exonerate the innocent, to prevent DNA analysis backlogs, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
- 2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (S. 139)
- 3 to implement the use of Rapid DNA instruments to inform

5 against consideration of the bill are waived. An amend-
6 ment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text
7 of Rules Committee Print 115-53 shall be considered as
8 adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read.
9 All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amend-
10 ed, are waived. The previous question shall be considered
11 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further
12 amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening
13 motion except: (1) one hour of debate, with 40 minutes
14 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking
15 minority member of the Permanent Select Committee on
16 Intelligence and 20 minutes equally divided and controlled
17 by the chair and ranking minority member of the Com-
18 mittee on the Judiciary; (2) the further amendment print-
19 ed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
20 this resolution, if offered by the Member designated in the
21 report, which shall be in order without intervention of any
22 point of order, shall be considered as read, shall be sepa-
23 rately debatable for the time specified in the report equally
24 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,
25 and shall not be subject to a demand for division of the

1 question; and (3) one motion to commit with or without
2 instructions.
