AN ACT

- To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to clarify that the parsonage allowance exclusion is limited to the fair rental value of the property.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Clergy Housing Allow-3 ance Clarification Act of 2002".

4 SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF PARSONAGE ALLOWANCE EX-5 CLUSION.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 107 of the Internal Rev-7 enue Code of 1986 is amended by inserting before the pe-8 riod at the end of paragraph (2) "and to the extent such 9 allowance does not exceed the fair rental value of the 10 home, including furnishings and appurtenances such as a 11 garage, plus the cost of utilities".

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

13 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by
14 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning
15 after December 31, 2001.

16 (2) RETURNS POSITIONS.—The amendment
17 made by this section also shall apply to any taxable
18 year beginning before January 1, 2002, for which
19 the taxpayer—

20 (A) on a return filed before April 17,
21 2002, limited the exclusion under section 107 of
22 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as provided
23 in such amendment, or

24 (B) filed a return after April 16, 2002.

25 (3) OTHER YEARS BEFORE 2002.—Except as
26 provided in paragraph (2), notwithstanding any
HR 4156 RFS

prior regulation, revenue ruling, or other guidance
 issued by the Internal Revenue Service, no person
 shall be subject to the limitations added to section
 107 of such Code by this Act for any taxable year
 beginning before January 1, 2002.
