Making supplemental appropriations for the United States Patent and Trademark Office for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the
 fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, and for other pur poses, namely:

6 UNITED STATES PATENT AND TRADEMARK OFFICE

7 For an additional amount for "Salaries and Ex-8 penses" of the United States Patent and Trademark Of-9 fice, \$129,000,000, to remain available until expended: 10 *Provided*, That the sum herein appropriated from the general fund shall be reduced as offsetting collections assessed 11 12 and collected pursuant to 15 U.S.C. 1113 and 35 U.S.C. 13 41 and 376 are received during fiscal year 2010, so as to result in a fiscal year 2010 appropriation from the gen-14 15 eral fund estimated at \$0: Provided further, That during fiscal year 2010, should the total amount of offsetting fee 16 17 collections be less than \$2,016,000,000, this amount shall 18 be reduced accordingly.
