2	money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the
3	fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, and for other pur-

11	eral fund shall be reduced as offsetting collections assessed
12	and collected pursuant to 15 U.S.C. 1113 and 35 U.S.C.
13	41 and 376 are received during fiscal year 2010, so as
14	to result in a fiscal year 2010 appropriation from the gen-
15	eral fund estimated at \$0: Provided further, That during
16	fiscal year 2010, should the total amount of offsetting fee
17	collections be less than \$2,016,000,000, this amount shall
