#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Securely Expediting
Clearances Through Reporting Transparency Act of
2017" or the "SECRET Act of 2017".

# 1SEC. 2. REPORT ON BACKLOG OF PERSONNEL SECURITY2CLEARANCE INVESTIGATIONS.

3 Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment 4 of this Act, and quarterly thereafter for 5 years, the Direc-5 tor of the National Background Investigations Bureau of 6 the Office of Personnel Management shall submit to Con-7 gress a report on the backlog of security clearance inves-8 tigations that includes—

9 (1) the size of the personnel security clearance10 investigation process backlog; and

(2) the average length of time, for each sensitivity level, to carry out an initial investigation and
a periodic investigation.
