1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Ensuring Veteran En3 terprise Participation in Strategic Sourcing Act".

SEC. 2. SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS CERTIFI-4 5 CATION OF SUFFICIENT PARTICIPATION OF 6 SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS OWNED AND 7 CONTROLLED BY VETERANS AND SMALL 8 **BUSINESS CONCERNS OWNED BY VETERANS** 9 WITH SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITIES IN 10 CONTRACTS UNDER THE FEDERAL STRA-11 TEGIC SOURCING INITIATIVE.

12 (a) CERTIFICATION REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 13 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall submit to the Committees 14 on Veterans' Affairs of the House of Representatives and 15 16 the Senate certification in writing that with respect to 17 each contract (except for domestic delivery services) 18 awarded under the Federal Strategic Sourcing Initiative 19 (managed by the Office of Federal Procurement Policy) 20 a sufficient number of small business concerns owned and 21 controlled by veterans and a sufficient number of small 22 business concerns owned and controlled by veterans with 23 service-connected disabilities are represented within each 24 category.

25 (b) INSUFFICIENT REPRESENTATION.—If the Sec26 retary determines that the representation by small busi•HR 2781 EH

14	(c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
15	(1) The terms "small business concern owned
16	and controlled by veterans" and "small business
17	concern owned and controlled by veterans with serv-
18	ice-connected disabilities" have the meaning given
19	such terms in section 8127(k) of title 38, United
20	States Code.
21	(2) The term "category" means—
22	(A) a type of supply or service for which
23	a suite of contracts has been established under
23 24	a suite of contracts has been established under the Federal Strategic Sourcing Initiative; or

(B) any further subdivision or grouping
within such a suite of contracts.
(3) The term "sufficient number", with respect
to a type of business concern, means not fewer than
two and enough to maximize the percentage of or ders entered into by the Secretary with such busi ness concerns, as determined by the Secretary.
