AN ACT

- To authorize the purchase of a small parcel of Natural Resources Conservation Service property in Riverside, California, by the Riverside Corona Resource Conservation District, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. FINDINGS.

- (1) Since 1935, the United States has owned a parcel of land in Riverside, California, consisting of approximately 8.75 acres, more specifically described in section 2(a) (in this section referred to as the "property").
 - (2) The property is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Agriculture and has been variously used for research and plant materials purposes.
 - (3) Since 1998, the property has been administered by the Natural Resources Conservation Service of the Department of Agriculture.
 - (4) Since 2002, the property has been co-managed under a cooperative agreement between the Natural Resources Conservation Service and the Riverside Corona Resource Conservation District, which is a legal subdivision of the State of California under section 9003 of the California Public Resources Code.
 - (5) The Conservation District wishes to purchase the property and use it for conservation, environmental, and related educational purposes.
 - (6) As provided in section 2, the purchase of the property by the Conservation District would promote the conservation education and related activi-

- 3 SEC. 2. LAND PURCHASE, NATURAL RESOURCES CON-
- 4 SERVATION SERVICE PROPERTY, RIVERSIDE
- 5 COUNTY, CALIFORNIA.
- 6 (a) Purchase Authorized.—The Secretary of Ag-
- 7 riculture shall sell and quitclaim to the Riverside Corona
- 8 Resource Conservation District (in this section referred to
- 9 as the "Conservation District") all right, title, and interest
- 10 of the United States in and to a parcel of real property,
- 11 including improvements thereon, that is located at 4500
- 12 Glenwood Drive in Riverside, California, consists of ap-
- 13 proximately 8.75 acres, and is administered by the Nat-
- 14 ural Resources Conservation Service of the Department of
- 15 Agriculture. As necessary or desirable to facilitate the pur-
- 16 chase of the property under this section, the Secretary or
- 17 the Conservation District may survey all or portions of
- 18 the property.
- 19 (b) Consideration.—As consideration for the pur-
- 20 chase of the property under this section, the Conservation
- 21 District shall pay to the Secretary of Agriculture an
- 22 amount equal to the appraised value of the property.
- 23 (c) Prohibition on Reservation of Interest.—
- 24 The Secretary of Agriculture shall not reserve any future
- 25 interest in the property to be conveyed under this section,

- 1 except such interest as may be acceptable to the Conserva-
- 2 tion District.
- 3 (d) Hazardous Substances.—Notwithstanding
- 4 section 120(h) of the Comprehensive Environmental Re-
- 5 sponse, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (42)
- 6 U.S.C. 9620(h)) or the Solid Waste Disposal Act (42
- 7 U.S.C. 6901 et seq.), in the case of the property purchased
- 8 by the Conservation District under this section, the Sec-
- 9 retary of Agriculture shall be only required to meet the
- 10 disclosure requirements for hazardous substances, pollut-
- 11 ants, or contaminants, but shall otherwise not be required
- 12 to remediate or abate any such releases of hazardous sub-
- 13 stances, pollutants, or contaminants, including petroleum
- 14 and petroleum derivatives.
- (e) Cooperative Authority.—
- 16 (1) Leases, contracts, and cooperative
- 17 AGREEMENTS AUTHORIZED.—In conjunction with, or
- in addition to, the purchase of the property by the
- 19 Conservation District under this section, the Sec-
- 20 retary of Agriculture may enter into leases, con-
- 21 tracts and cooperative agreements with the Con-
- servation District.
- 23 (2) Sole source.—Notwithstanding sections
- 24 3105, 3301, and 3303 to 3305 of title 41, United
- 25 States Code, or any other provision of law, the Sec-

- 1 retary may lease real property from the Conserva-2 tion District on a noncompetitive basis.
- 3 (3) Non-exclusive authority.—The author-
- 4 ity provided by this subsection is in addition to any
- 5 other authority of the Secretary.
