

In the Senate of the United States,

September 15, 2011.

Resolved, That the resolution from the House of Representatives (H.J. Res. 66) entitled “Joint resolution approving the renewal of import restrictions contained in the Burmese Freedom and Democracy Act of 2003.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Strike all after the resolving clause and insert the following:

8 *(a) IN GENERAL.—Congress approves the renewal of*
9 *the import restrictions contained in section 3(a)(1) and sec-*

1 *tion 3A (b)(1) and (c)(1) of the Burmese Freedom and De-*
 2 *mocracy Act of 2003.*

3 *(b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—This division shall be*
 4 *deemed to be a “renewal resolution” for purposes of section*
 5 *9 of the Burmese Freedom and Democracy Act of 2003.*

6 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

7 *This division shall take effect on the date of the enact-*
 8 *ment of this joint resolution or July 26, 2011, whichever*
 9 *occurs earlier.*

For an additional amount for “Mississippi River and Tributaries” for expenses resulting from a major disaster designation pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5122(2)), \$890,177,300, to remain available until expended for repair of damages to Federal projects: Provided, That the amount in this paragraph shall not become available for obligation until October 1, 2011: Provided further, That the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works shall provide a monthly report to the Committees on Appropriations of the House of Representatives and the Senate detailing the allocation and obligation of these funds, beginning not later than 60 days after enactment of this Act: Provided further, That each amount in this paragraph is designated by Congress as being for disaster relief pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(D) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (Public Law 99–177), as amended.

OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

For an additional amount for “Operation and Maintenance”, \$60,000,000, to remain available until expended to

1 dredge navigation channels and repair damage to Corps
2 projects nationwide related to natural disasters: Provided,
3 That the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works
4 shall provide a monthly report to the Committees on Appro-
5 priations of the House of Representatives and the Senate
6 detailing the allocation and obligation of these funds, begin-
7 ning not later than 60 days after enactment of this Act:
8 Provided further, That the amount in this paragraph is des-
9 ignated by Congress as being for an emergency requirement
10 pursuant to section 3(c)(1) of H. Res. 5 (112th Congress)
11 and to section 403(a) of S. Con. Res. 13 (111th Congress),
12 the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 2010.

13 For an additional amount for “Operation and Mainte-
14 nance” for expenses resulting from a major disaster des-
15 ignation pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief
16 and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5122(2)) to
17 dredge navigation channels and repair damage to Corps
18 projects nationwide related to natural disasters,
19 \$88,003,700, to remain available until expended: Provided,
20 That the amount in this paragraph shall not become avail-
21 able for obligation until October 1, 2011: Provided further,
22 That the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works
23 shall provide a monthly report to the Committees on Appro-
24 priations of the House of Representatives and the Senate
25 detailing the allocation and obligation of these funds, begin-

1 *ning not later than 60 days after enactment of this Act:*

11 *to prepare for flood, hurricane and other natural disasters*
12 *and support emergency operations, repair and other activi-*
13 *ties in response to recent natural disasters as authorized*
14 *by law, \$244,000,000, to remain available until expended:*
15 *Provided, That the Assistant Secretary of the Army for*
16 *Civil Works shall provide a monthly report to the Commit-*
17 *tees on Appropriations of the House of Representatives and*
18 *the Senate detailing the allocation and obligation of these*
19 *funds, beginning not later than 60 days after enactment*
20 *of this Act: Provided further, That the amount in this para-*
21 *graph is designated by Congress as being for an emergency*
22 *requirement pursuant to section 3(c)(1) of H. Res. 5 (112th*
23 *Congress) and to section 403(a) of S. Con. Res. 13 (111th*
24 *Congress), the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal*
25 *year 2010.*

1 *For an additional amount for “Flood Control and*
2 *Coastal Emergencies”, for expenses resulting from a major*
3 *disaster designation pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Dis-*
4 *aster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C.*
5 *5122(2)) and as authorized by section 5 of the Act of August*
6 *18, 1941 (33 U.S.C. 701n), for necessary expenses to pre-*
7 *pare for flood, hurricane and other natural disasters and*
8 *support emergency operations, repair and other activities*
9 *in response to recent natural disasters as authorized by law,*
10 *\$66,387,000, to remain available until expended: Provided,*
11 *That the amount in this paragraph shall not become avail-*
12 *able for obligation until October 1, 2011: Provided further,*
13 *That the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works*
14 *shall provide a monthly report to the Committees on Appro-*
15 *priations of the House of Representatives and the Senate*
16 *detailing the allocation and obligation of these funds, begin-*
17 *ning not later than 60 days after enactment of this Act:*
18 *Provided further, That each amount in this paragraph is*
19 *designated by Congress as being for disaster relief pursuant*
20 *to section 251(b)(2)(D) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-*
21 *gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (Public Law 99–177),*
22 *as amended.*

FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY

DISASTER RELIEF

For an additional amount for “Disaster Relief”, \$500,000,000, to remain available until expended: Provided, That the amount in this paragraph is designated by Congress as being for an emergency requirement pursuant to section 3(c)(1) of H. Res. 5 (112th Congress) and to section 403(a) of S. Con. Res. 13 (111th Congress), the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 2010.

For an additional amount for the “Disaster Relief” for expenses resulting from a major disaster designation pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5122(2)), \$4,600,000,000, to remain available until expended: Provided, That the amount in this paragraph shall not become available for obligation until October 1, 2011: Provided further, That such amount is designated by Congress as being for disaster relief pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(D) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (Public Law 99–177), as amended. This Act may be cited as the “Emergency Supplemental Disaster Relief Appropriations Resolution, 2011”.

COMMUNITY PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND

For an additional amount for the “Community Development Fund”, for necessary expenses related to disaster relief, long-term recovery, and restoration of infrastructure, housing, and economic revitalization resulting from a major disaster designation pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5122(2)) in 2011, \$100,000,000, to remain available until expended, for activities authorized under title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Public Law 93–383): Provided, That the amount in this paragraph shall not become available for obligation until October 1, 2011: Provided further, That such amount is designated by Congress as being for disaster relief pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(D) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (Public Law 99–177), as amended: Provided further, That funds shall be awarded directly to the State or unit of general local government at the discretion of the Secretary: Provided further, That prior to the obligation of funds a grantee shall submit a plan to the Secretary detailing the proposed use of all funds,

1 *including criteria for eligibility and how the use of these*
2 *funds will address long-term recovery and restoration of in-*
3 *frastructure: Provided further, That funds provided under*
4 *this heading may be used by a State or locality as a match-*
5 *ing requirement, share, or contribution for any other Fed-*
6 *eral program: Provided further, That such funds may not*
7 *be used for activities reimbursable by, or for which funds*
8 *are made available by, the Federal Emergency Management*
9 *Agency or the Army Corps of Engineers: Provided further,*
10 *That funds allocated under this heading shall not adversely*
11 *affect the amount of any formula assistance received by a*
12 *State or subdivision thereof under the Community Develop-*
13 *ment Fund: Provided further, That a State or subdivision*
14 *thereof may use up to 5 percent of its allocation for admin-*
15 *istrative costs: Provided further, That in administering the*
16 *funds under this heading, the Secretary of Housing and*
17 *Urban Development may waive, or specify alternative re-*
18 *quirements for, any provision of any statute or regulation*
19 *that the Secretary administers in connection with the obli-*
20 *gation by the Secretary or the use by the recipient of these*
21 *funds or guarantees (except for requirements related to fair*
22 *housing, nondiscrimination, labor standards, and the envi-*
23 *ronment), upon a request by a State or subdivision thereof*
24 *explaining why such waiver is required to facilitate the use*
25 *of such funds or guarantees, if the Secretary finds that such*

1 *waiver would not be inconsistent with the overall purpose*
2 *of title I of the Housing and Community Development Act*
3 *of 1974: Provided further, That the Secretary shall publish*
4 *in the Federal Register any waiver of any statute or regula-*
5 *tion that the Secretary administers pursuant to title I of*
6 *the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 no*
7 *later than 5 days before the effective date of such waiver.*
8 *This division may be cited as the “Emergency Supple-*
9 *mental Disaster Relief Appropriations Resolution, 2011”.*
