 SECTION 1. RENEWAL OF IMPORT RESTRICTIONS UNDER
 BURMESE FREEDOM AND DEMOCRACY ACT
 OF 2003.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Congress approves the renewal of
 the import restrictions contained in section 3(a)(1) and
 section 3A (b)(1) and (c)(1) of the Burmese Freedom and
 Democracy Act of 2003.

5 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—This joint resolution
6 shall be deemed to be a "renewal resolution" for purposes
7 of section 9 of the Burmese Freedom and Democracy Act
8 of 2003.

9 SEC. 2. PAYGO COMPLIANCE.

10 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of 11 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010, 12 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement 13 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this 14 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record 15 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-16 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the 17 vote on passage.

1 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

2 This joint resolution shall take effect on the date of
3 the enactment of this joint resolution or July 26, 2011,
4 whichever occurs earlier.
