AN ACT

- To reaffirm that certain land has been taken into trust for the benefit of the Poarch Band of Creek Indians, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Poarch Band of Creek3 Indians Land Reaffirmation Act".

4 SEC. 2. REAFFIRMATION OF INDIAN TRUST LAND.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Lands described in subsection (b) 6 that were taken into trust by the United States for the 7 benefit of the Poarch Band of Creek Indians prior to the 8 date of enactment of this Act are reaffirmed, subject to 9 valid existing rights, as trust land and shall remain as In-10 dian country under section 1151 of title 18, United States 11 Code.

12 (b) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The land referred to in13 subsection (a) is comprised of the following:

14 (1) The approximately $229\frac{1}{2}$ acres described in 15 the final Notice of the Department of the Interior's 16 Poarch Band of Creeks Establishment of Reserva-17 tion (50 Fed. Reg. 15502 (April 18, 1985)), and 18 Poarch Band of Creeks; Establishment of Reserva-19 tion: Correction (50 Fed. Reg. 19813 (May 10, 20 (1985)), and shown on Poarch Band of Creek Indians Trust Lands Maps 1, 2, and 5 as "Reserva-21 22 tion".

(2) The approximately 1 acre named as Parcel
5 located within the exterior geographic boundaries
of Escambia County, Florida, which was taken into
trust by the Department of the Interior via Statu•HR 1532 EH

1 tory Warranty Deed on November 21, 1984, shown 2 on Poarch Band of Creek Indians Trust Lands Map 3 7, and further described as: 4 Commence at the Southeast corner of the 5 Northwest Quarter of Section 5, Township 5 6 North, Range 33 West, Escambia County, Flor-7 ida; thence go West along the South line of the 8 Northwest Quarter of said Section 5 for a dis-9 tance of 420 feet; thence run North for a dis-10 tance of 40 feet to the point of beginning; 11 thence continue North along said line for a dis-12 tance of 210 feet; thence run West for a dis-13 tance of 210 feet; thence run South for a dis-14 tance of 210 feet; thence run East 210 feet to

14 tance of 210 feet; thence run East 210 feet to
15 the point of beginning, containing one acre,
16 more or less.

(3) The approximately 1 acre named as Parcel
6 located within the exterior geographic boundaries
of Monroe County, Alabama, which was taken into
trust by the Department of the Interior via Statutory Warranty Deed on November 21, 1984, shown
on Poarch Band of Creek Indians Trust Lands Map
3, and further described as:

One acre in a square in Southeast cornerof the ten-acre strip on the North side of South

1	Half of Southeast Quarter lying West of the
2	highway in Section 26, Township 5 North,
3	Range 6 East, being the same property con-
4	veyed to the Grantor by deed dated July 23,
5	1984 and filed for record in the office of the
6	Judge of Probate of Monroe County, Alabama
7	on July 23, 1984, and by correction deed dated
8	November 21, 1984.
9	(4) The approximately 10 acres named as Par-
10	cel 12 located within the exterior geographic bound-
11	aries of Escambia County, Alabama, which were
12	taken into trust by the Department of the Interior
13	via Correction Deed on November 21, 1988, shown
14	on Poarch Band of Creek Indians Trust Lands Map
15	4, and further described as:
16	Begin at a $2''$ iron pipe at the intersection
17	of the South line of Section 5, Township 1
18	North, Range 6 East, and the East right of
19	way line of Alabama State Highway No. 21;
20	thence run S 89° 03′ 00″ E along said South
21	line of Section 5 a distance of 860.93 feet;
22	thence run N 00° 04' 57" W a distance of
23	608.47 feet; thence run N 89° 56' 20" W a dis-
24	tance of 575.73 feet to the aforementioned East
25	right of way line of Alabama State Highway

1	No. 21; thence run S 25° 32′ 21″ W along said
2	East right of way line a distance of 659.22 feet
3	to the point of beginning, said property lying
4	and being all in Section 5, Township 1 North,
5	Range 6 East, and containing 10.09 acres,
6	more or less.
7	(5) The approximately 10 acres named as Par-
8	cel 10 located within the exterior geographic bound-
9	aries of Escambia County, Alabama, which were
10	taken into trust by the Department of the Interior
11	via Warranty Deed on August 17, 1992, shown on
12	Poarch Band of Creek Indians Trust Lands Map 2,
13	and further described as:
14	Commencing at the Southeast corner of
15	the Northeast $1/4$ of Southwest $1/4$ - Section
16	28 Township 2 North Range 6 East; thence
17	North 577.5 feet; thence North 89 degrees
18	West 2726 feet to the point of beginning;
19	thence North 89 degrees West 100 feet; thence
20	South 210 feet; thence North 89 degrees West
21	855 feet; thence South 0 degrees 21 minutes
22	West 378.37 feet; thence South 84 degrees 40
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23	minutes East 966 feet; thence North 28 degrees

1	grees West 148 feet; thence North 395.34 feet
2	to point of beginning. Containing 10.08 acres.
3	(6) The approximately 52 acres named as Par-
4	cel 14 located within the exterior geographic bound-
5	aries of Escambia County, Alabama, which was
6	taken into trust by the Department of the Interior
7	via Warranty Deed on August 17, 1992, shown on
8	Poarch Band of Creek Indians Trust Lands Map 1,
9	and further described as:
10	All of the North half of Northwest Quarter
11	of Section 34, Township 2 North, Range 5 East
12	lying East of the Poarch-Perdido Road.
13	(7) The approximately 31 acres named as Par-
14	cel 15 located within the exterior geographic bound-
15	aries of Escambia County, Alabama, which were
16	taken into trust by Warranty Deed on August 17,
17	1992, shown on Poarch Band of Creek Indians
18	Trust Lands Map 1, and further described as:
19	All of the West Half of Northwest Quarter
20	of Section 34, Township 2 North, Range 5 East
21	lying North of Dees Road and West of the
22	Poarch-Perdido Road.
23	(8) The approximately 8 acres named as Parcel
24	16 located within the exterior geographic boundaries
25	of Escambia County, Alabama, which were taken

into trust by the Department of the Interior via
 Warranty Deed on August 17, 1992, shown on
 Poarch Band of Creek Indians Trust Lands Map 1,
 and further described as:

5 Beginning at the Southwest corner of 6 Northwest Quarter of Southwest Quarter of 7 Section 27, Township 2 North, Range 5 East; 8 thence run East 1145 feet to the public road; 9 thence North 3 degrees 15 minutes East 380 10 feet along said road; thence run West 1167 11 feet; thence run South 380 feet to point of be-12 ginning containing ten acres, except two acres 13 described as follows:

14 Beginning at the aforesaid point of begin-15 ning thence run East 848 feet to the starting 16 point; thence run North 297 feet, thence run 17 East 298 feet, more or less, to the West right 18 of way of Old Sullivan Mill Road; thence run 19 Southwesterly along said right of way to the 20 South line of Northwest Quarter of Southwest 21 Quarter of said Section 27; thence run West 22 297 feet to the starting point, containing eight 23 acres, more or less.

Commence at a one-inch metal pipe being 0 7 the Southwest corner of Section 27, Township 8 2 North, Range 5 East Escambia County, Alabama; thence go N 00° 38' 26" W along the 9 10 West line of said Section 27 for a distance of 11 8.0 feet to a point on the Northerly right of 12 way line of Jackson Road (40 foot right of 13 way), said point also being the point of beginning; thence continue N 00° 38' 26" W along 14 said West section line for a distance of 1321.23 15 16 feet to the Northwest corner of the Southwest 17 Quarter of Southwest Quarter at said Section 27; thence go N 89° 30' 13" E along the North 18 19 line of said Southwest Quarter of Southwest 20 Quarter for a distance of 1146.48 feet to the Westerly right of way line of Poarch-Perdido 21 Road (40 foot right of way); thence go S 00° 22 34' 55" W along said Westerly right of way line 23 for a distance of 287.65 feet: thence go S 01° 24 30' 05" W for a distance of 40.0 feet; thence 25

1	go S $00^\circ~00^\prime~31^{\prime\prime}$ W along afores aid Westerly
2	right of way line for a distance of 195.59 feet;
3	thence go S $02^{\circ} 34' 30''$ W along aforesaid
4	right of way line for a distance of 172.73 feet;
5	thence go S $04^{\circ} 24' 35''$ W along aforesaid
6	right of way for a distance of 630.72 feet to the
7	intersection with the Northerly right of way of
8	said Jackson Road; thence go S 89 39' 16" W
9	along said Northerly right of way line for a dis-
10	tance of 1071.43 feet to the point of beginning,
11	it being the intention to describe herein and
12	convey hereby all of the Southwest Quarter of
13	Southwest Quarter of Section 27, Township 2
14	North, Range 5 East, lying West of the public
15	road.
16	(10) The approximately 13 acres named as Par-
17	cel 17 located within the exterior geographic bound-
18	aries of Montgomery County, Alabama, which were
19	taken into trust by the Department of the Interior
20	via Warranty Deed on March 23, 1995, shown on
21	Poarch Band of Creek Indians Trust Lands Map 6,
22	and further described as:
23	Commence at the SW corner of Section 27,
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T-17-N, R-19-E, Montgomery County, Alabama and run EAST, 4340.49 feet; thence

NORTH, 1806.29 feet to a point on existing 1 2 fence line and being the Point of Beginning; 3 continue Thence along said fence line S89°13′03″E, 136.34 feet; Thence continue 4 5 along said fence line S23°49'20" E, 62.92 feet; 6 Thence continue along said fence line 7 N69°23'34"E, 219.92 feet to an existing iron 8 pin; Thence continue along said fence line 9 N17°23′26″W, 968.84 feet to an existing iron 10 leaving said pin; Thence fence line 11 $N18^{\circ}23'28''W$, 503.62 feet to a point on the 12 southeast edge of the Tallapoosa River; Thence 13 along said edge S43°24'16"W, 618.01 feet; 14 Thence leaving said edge S39°49′22″E, 150.00 15 feet to a point on an existing fence line; Thence along said fence line S26°17′56″E, 374.05 feet; 16 17 Thence continue along said fence line 18 S39°39′24″E, 198.60 feet; Thence continue 19 along said fence line S17°38′01″E, 386.15 feet 20 to the Point of Beginning. All lying in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ 21 Section 27, T-17-N, R-19-E, Montgomery 22 County, Alabama, and containing 12.86 acres 23 more or less.

(c) APPLICATION.—This Act shall apply to all claims,including claims challenging the validity of title or the ef-

fectiveness of any action of the Secretary acquiring and
 taking land described in subsection (b) into trust, that are
 pending on the date of enactment of this Act, or that are
 filed on or after that date.
