AN ACT

To amend title 5, United States Code, to allow whistleblowers
to disclose information to certain recipients.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. RECIPIENTS OF WHISTLEBLOWER DISCLO-**
2 **SURES.**

3 Section 2302(b)(8)(B) of title 5, United States Code,
4 is amended by striking “or to the Inspector” and all that
5 follows through “such disclosures” and inserting “the In-
6 spector General of an agency, a supervisor in the employ-
7 ee’s direct chain of command up to and including the head
8 of the employing agency, or to an employee designated by
9 any of the aforementioned individuals for the purpose of
10 receiving such disclosures”.
