AN ACT

- To amend title 5, United States Code, to require that the Office of Personnel Management submit an annual report to Congress relating to the use of official time by Federal employees.
- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

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1 SECTION 1. REPORTING REQUIREMENT.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 7131 of title 5, United
3 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol4 lowing:

5 "(e)(1)(A) Not later than March 31 of each calendar
6 year, the Office of Personnel Management, in consultation
7 with the Office of Management and Budget, shall submit
8 to each House of Congress a report on the operation of
9 this section during the fiscal year last ending before the
10 start of such calendar year.

"(B) Not later than December 31 of each calendar
year, each agency (as defined by section 7103(a)(3)) shall
furnish to the Office of Personnel Management the information which such Office requires, with respect to such
agency, for purposes of the report which is next due under
subparagraph (A).

17 "(2) Each report by the Office of Personnel Manage18 ment under this subsection shall include, with respect to
19 the fiscal year described in paragraph (1)(A), at least the
20 following information:

- 21 "(A) The total amount of official time granted22 to employees.
- 23 "(B) The average amount of official time ex-24 pended per bargaining unit employee.
- 25 "(C) The specific types of activities or purposes
 26 for which official time was granted, and the impact
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1	which the granting of such official time for such ac-
2	tivities or purposes had on agency operations.
3	"(D) The total number of employees to whom
4	official time was granted, and, of that total, the
5	number who were not engaged in any activities or
6	purposes except activities or purposes involving the
7	use of official time.
8	((E) The total amount of compensation (includ-
9	ing fringe benefits) afforded to employees in connec-
10	tion with activities or purposes for which they were
11	granted official time.
12	"(F) The total amount of official time spent by
13	employees representing Federal employees who are
14	not union members in matters authorized by this
15	chapter.
16	"(G) A description of any room or space des-
17	ignated at the agency (or its subcomponent) where
18	official time activities will be conducted, including
19	the square footage of any such room or space.
20	"(3) All information included in a report by the Of-
21	fice of Personnel Management under this subsection with
22	respect to a fiscal year—
23	"(A) shall be shown both agency-by-agency and
24	for all agencies; and

"(B) shall be accompanied by the corresponding
 information (submitted by the Office in its report
 under this subsection) for the fiscal year before the
 fiscal year to which such report pertains, together
 with appropriate comparisons and analyses.

6 "(4) For purposes of this subsection, the term 'offi7 cial time' means any period of time, regardless of agency
8 nomenclature—

9 "(A) which may be granted to an employee 10 under this chapter (including a collective bargaining 11 agreement entered into under this chapter) to per-12 form representational or consultative functions; and 13 "(B) during which the employee would other-14 wise be in a duty status.".

(b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by subsection (a) shall be effective beginning with the report
which, under the provisions of such amendment, is first
required to be submitted by the Office of Personnel Management to each House of Congress by a date which oc-

curs at least 6 months after the date of the enactment
 of this Act.
