## A BILL

To amend title 40, United States Code, to promote regional economic and infrastructure development, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Northern Border Re-  
5 gional Commission Reauthorization Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF REGIONAL COM-**  
2 **MISSIONS.**

3 Section 15304(c)(3)(A) of title 40, United States  
4 Code, is amended by striking “unanimous” and inserting  
5 “majority”.

6 **SEC. 3. ECONOMIC AND INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT**  
7 **GRANTS.**

8 Section 15501 of title 40, United States Code, is  
9 amended—

10 (1) in subsection (b) by striking “paragraphs  
11 (1) through (3)” and inserting “paragraph (1), (2),  
12 (3), or (7)”; and

13 (2) in subsection (f) by striking the period at  
14 the end and inserting “, except that financial assist-  
15 ance may be used as otherwise authorized by this  
16 subtitle to attract businesses to the region from out-  
17 side the United States.”.

18 **SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

19 Section 15751(a) of title 40, United States Code, is  
20 amended by striking “2018” and inserting “2023”.

21 **SEC. 5. TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.**

22 Chapters 1, 2, 3, and 4 of subtitle V of title 40,  
23 United States Code, are redesignated as chapters 151,  
24 153, 155, and 157, respectively.
