Congressman Ted Deutch Service Academy Application Procedure

- 1. **Application and Photograph**—Complete the application and attach a recent photograph.
- Standardized Test Scores SAT or ACT scores must be sent to the office directly from the testing center. Please use the following codes
 SAT 5425 ACT 7341
- 3. **Transcript** Official transcripts, including your current GPA, numerical class rank and complete course listing, must be submitted in a sealed envelope, signed across the seal by a school official. **If you are currently enrolled in a post-secondary educational institute, a transcript will need to be provided from that school/university. **If you are a freshman and your grades have not been released, you must obtain letters, from each teacher, reflecting your academic performance thus far.
- 4. Letters of Recommendation Three letters of recommendation must be submitted by each applicant. It is recommended that one be from your principal or guidance counselor. (If you are enrolled in a post-secondary educational institute, this letter should come from your academic advisor.) One of your letters should be from a math or science teacher. (If you are enrolled in a post-secondary educational institute this letter should come from your current math or science professor/instructor.) The final letter may be from anyone you choose, as long as you are not related to him/her. Each letter must be submitted in a sealed envelope, signed across the seal by the person making the recommendation.
- 5. **Application Packet Deadline -** The deadline for submitting a complete application packet is **November 1**. A complete application packet consists of an application, an essay, SAT or ACT scores, official transcripts and three letters of recommendation.
- 6. **There is no interview process**. Nominations are made based on your application packet and monthly evaluations from the Service Academies. Nominations letters are sent in early December.
