# COMPLETE APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED IN CONGRESSMAN SENSENBRENNER'S BROOKFIELD OFFICE NO LATER THAN CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 12, 2018.

In addition to returning a completed application form, candidates must provide the following information:

- 1. Three letters of reference from members of the community, one of which must be from an instructor or school administrator. Letters from immediate relatives will not be accepted.
- 2. Certified transcripts of the most recent high school or college record.
- 3. Results of Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) and/or the American College Testing Program (ACT) test. *The SAT code number is 1701 and the ACT code number is 7758*. Copies of the ACT and SAT test results that have been certified by the school are also acceptable.
- 4. One photograph, 3 ½" by 5" or larger. The photo can be mailed with the packet. It does not need to be a professional shot.

Candidates for appointment to an academy will be required to have a comprehensive medical exam at an official military examination center at a later time.

High school guidance counselors have a great deal of information concerning available dates, locations, and times to take the SAT and ACT. Additional information concerning the SAT is made available by contacting the College Entrance Examination Board in Princeton, New Jersey, while information pertaining to the ACT will be found with the American College Testing Program in Iowa City, Iowa. Please note that the candidates for the US Military Academy are now required to submit a writing score with their ACT exam. If you have registered for the ACT without selecting the 'ACT Writing Plus' exam, you should contact ACT directly at (319) 337-1270.

Congressman Sensenbrenner utilizes a Fifth Congressional District Academy Selection Committee to interview and evaluate applicants, and to recommend the best qualified individuals for nomination to the academies. Upon receiving the recommendations, Congressman Sensenbrenner will designate a principal nominee to each academy, and competing alternates will also be named. Nominations will be announced in late December.

The Air Force, Military and Naval Academies will then select candidates for appointment. In the case of the Merchant Marine Academy, the Congressional nominees compete on a nationwide basis. All nominees from the State of Wisconsin compete for the six vacancies allotted to our state.

Final examinations and appointments are entirely under the jurisdiction of the academies. Candidates who are selected must be fully qualified and meet all entry requirements. Appointees are usually notified by mid-April, following their final evaluations.
