1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Jobs From3 Government Interference Act".

4 SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF THE NLRB.

5 Section 10(c) of the National Labor Relations Act 6 (29 U.S.C. 160) is amended by inserting before the period at the end the following: ": Provided further, That the 7 8 Board shall have no power to order an employer (or seek 9 an order against an employer) to restore or reinstate any work, product, production line, or equipment, to rescind 10 any relocation, transfer, subcontracting, outsourcing, or 11 other change regarding the location, entity, or employer 12 13 who shall be engaged in production or other business oper-14 ations, or to require any employer to make an initial or 15 additional investment at a particular plant, facility, or lo-16 cation".

17 SEC. 3. RETROACTIVITY.

18 The amendment made by section 2 shall apply to any19 complaint for which a final adjudication by the National
