



## **Congressman Dave Reichert's Office (WA-08) Supplemental 2018 Congressional Art Competition Guidelines**

- Each student may only enter one piece of artwork.
- Each participating student must notify my office by e-mail of their intention to compete by April 23, 2018, with their full name, high school, e-mail address and phone number to [Jacques.Imperial@mail.house.gov](mailto:Jacques.Imperial@mail.house.gov).
- Each participating student must complete the student information and release form by April 23, 2018 to Jacques Imperial by e-mail: [Jacques.Imperial@mail.house.gov](mailto:Jacques.Imperial@mail.house.gov) or fax: 425.270.3589.
- Artwork must already be framed.
- Artwork must have wire hangers – no sawtooth hangers.
- There is a possibility that artwork, frames, and glass may be damaged or broken during the course of the competition. Congressman Reichert's office is not responsible for these damages.
- Student must deliver artwork to Arts Alive! Center for the Arts on April 28 – April 29, between 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The artwork will be displayed on May 1st until the reception on May 3rd. For students residing east of Snoqualmie Pass, please deliver to our Wenatchee office by April 27, 2018.
- Students must pick up their artwork at the conclusion of the reception or have someone else do so on May 3, 2018. Arts Alive! Center for the Arts will keep any remaining artwork until May 5, 2018, or it will be subject to disposal.
- In the case of the winner, artwork must be picked up within 30 days of the student being notified that our district office has received it from Washington, D.C.
