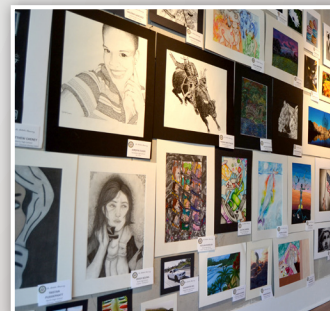


2017 Overall winning piece titled, "Life of an Artist"
