In approximately 7-10 days, there is a possibility that the USG may be able to recover Sgt Bowe Bergdahl who has been in the custody of the Haqqani Taliban Network (HTN) since June of 2009. Attached documents provide background details on his captivity and intelligence assessments on his health. My understanding is that he would be brought back into Germany via C-17 to Ramstein for initial medical care and re-integration support at LRMC. Our planners are under the impression there may already be some DoS coord with the MFA and MOH for bringing him into country (contagious disease concerns).

Request your assistance to confirm DoS awareness and coord with the German government for their approval to bring Sgt Bergdahl to Ramstein/LRMC should USG negotiations lead to his release from the HTN. Thanks.
