To redesignate Gravelly Point Park, located along the George Washington Memorial Parkway in Arlington County, Virginia, as the Nancy Reagan Memorial Park, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 Gravelly Point Park, located along the George Wash-
5 ington Memorial Parkway in Arlington County, Virginia,
6 shall be redesignated as the “Nancy Reagan Memorial
7 Park”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to Gravelly
4 Point Park shall be deemed to be a reference to the Nancy
5 Reagan Memorial Park.
