

REPUBLICANS CASH IN ON THE #GOPTAXSCAM

Republicans Gave Their Wealthy Donors Billions of Dollars in Tax Cuts, and Their Donors Returned the Favor





An Update from the Democracy Reform Task Force February 14, 2018

INTRODUCTION

On the eve of releasing the first details of the Republican tax scam, Speaker Paul Ryan invited the American Action Network – an arm of the Koch Brothers' sprawling political organization – to a Republican conference meeting, where the big-money pressure organization played a handful of political ads for the assembled members of Congress. The message of the ads was clear: pass the tax scam and get rewarded with favorable political support; oppose it and you will get punished with negative attacks. Rank-and-file Republicans got the message. "Like a teacher showing the kids a paddle on the first day of class, the blatant implication was that those who misbehaved would be spanked," said one anonymous Republican.¹

As Republicans took their marching orders and raced to pass the #GOPTaxScam, the Democracy Reform Task Force issued a mini-report showing how Republicans openly admitted that pleasing their donors was the driving motivation for forcing their tax bill through Congress. With the #GOPTaxScam now on the books, Republican donors are keeping up their end of the bargain by opening up their checkbooks and offering Republicans generous campaign contributions and political support. This update from the Democracy Reform Task Force bookends the prior mini-report, highlighting how big money drives the agenda in Washington and puts the interests of wealthy donors ahead of the public interest.



"Thirteen days after the U.S. House passed its version of the tax legislation, Charles Koch and his wife, Elizabeth, combined to donate nearly \$500,000 to House Speaker Paul Ryan's joint fundraising committee."

Americans for Prosperity spent tens of millions of dollars urging GOP lawmakers to pass the tax cuts, including hosting events in at least 36 states and running ads, while asking its donors to call Republican legislators about the bill."

CONCLUSION

The Republican Party continues to cash-in on its passage of the #GOPTaxScam. Without a doubt, more examples will surface of big-money donors explicitly rewarding their Republican patrons in Congress for this massive giveaway. What's more, this corrupt strong-arming by the politically powerful will likely migrate to other policy debates in Congress.

For example, the recently released Trump Budget for fiscal year 2019 has the potential to dramatically reorder our nation's priorities in favor of big business and the wealthy, while harming hardworking Americans and the most vulnerable members of our society. ^{2,3} There is no reason to think big money donors won't continue to use their largess to bend the agenda in Washington in their favor – and there is no reason to think Republicans won't continue to oblige. Already, Republican Members of Congress are sharpening their knives to cut critical programs like Medicare and Social Security in order to pay for this wrongheaded tax giveaway. Americans of all political stripes deserve better. They deserve a Congress that works for the public interest, not special interests.
