4	(a) In General.—The Secretary of Labor shall
5	enter into an arrangement with the National Academies
6	to conduct a study of shifting workforce industry chal-
7	lenges and opportunities related to the displacement of
8	United States workers due to technological innovation.
9	Such study shall—
10	(1) assess demographic, training, technology,
11	and workforce needs;
12	(2) identify industry sectors likely to be signifi-
13	cantly impacted by automation; and
14	(3) provide recommendations for policy solu-

16	(b) REPORT.—Not later than 18 months after the
17	date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall sub-
