



COVID-19 Temporary Outdoor Dining Program Temporary Sidewalk Dining Permit


The following are step-by-step instructions for restaurant operators and their building owners applying for a Temporary Outdoor Sidewalk Dining Permit.

- Before beginning the application, read the <u>Temporary Outdoor Sidewalk Dining</u> <u>Guidelines</u> for eligibility criteria, applicant requirements, and application and review processes.
- 2. Applicants must submit an online application to Public Works through the County's Electronic Permitting and Inspections portal, <u>EPIC-LA</u>.
- 3. Once on the Epic-LA website, click Login or Register.






4. Register for a new account by clicking Register Here or log into an existing account.




5. After logging in, click Apply.






 On the Application Assistant page, type "COVID-19 Temporary Outdoor Dining – Sidewalk" in the search box and click search. The permit application will appear. Click **Apply** to continue to the application.




7. Follow the on-screen prompts to input the required information.





The last prompt on the application will be to upload the required documents before you can submit your application.



Required Documents:

- a. Description of the sidewalk encroachments (e.g., tables, chairs, etc.)
- b. Sketch of the proposed outdoor sidewalk dining layout depicting:
 - i. Dimensions of building frontage and proposed dining area
 - ii. Width of the sidewalk
 - iii. 5-foot obstruction-free pedestrian path along the property frontage during and outside business hours
 - iv. Any above-ground obstructions
 - v. Furnishings and equipment, including location and configuration when stored outside of business hours if different from service layout
- c. Evidence of Commercial General Liability insurance with a minimum \$1,000,000 per occurrence limit, naming the County of Los Angeles as an additional insured.
- d. A copy of the restaurant's valid Health Permit.
