Subject: Funding Announcement - Watershed and Flood Prevention Operations Program 2019 Consolidated Appropriations Act

Dear Congressman Ron Kind:

The 2019 Consolidated Appropriations Act provided \$150,000,000 for the Watershed and Flood Prevention Operations Program. The Wisconsin NRCS was allocated \$1,667,500 to assist La Crosse, Monroe, and Vernon Counties (Project Sponsors) with watershed planning in the Coon Creek and West Fork Kickapoo watersheds. The need for watershed planning arises from the failure of five dams during a flood on August 28, 2018. The primary purpose of planning is to prevent or reduce future flood damages.

The NRCS will contract technical services from an architectural and engineering firm to develop a Watershed Project Plan & Environmental Impact Statement in each watershed. The NRCS also will execute a project agreement with the University of Wisconsin - Madison to study changes in rainfall resulting from frequent and intense storms in the southwest region. Those findings will be integrated into the hydrologic modeling and economic evaluations associated with project proposals.
