APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

I. Minimum Nomination Requirements

To apply for a nomination to the **Air Force**, **Military**, **Naval**, **or Merchant Marine Academies**, you must meet all the following minimum requirements:

- be a U.S. citizen or national
- be at least 17 years old and not yet 23 years old on July 1 of the year the applicant would enter the academy (25 years old for USMMA)
- be unmarried, not pregnant, and without legal obligation to support children or other dependents
- demonstrate comprehensive academic preparation
- demonstrate leadership in athletics or other extracurricular activities
- take the SAT or the ACT
- be in good physical and mental health (the academies require a comprehensive medical exam and physical aptitude exam before acceptance)

Note: The U.S. Coast Guard Academy does not require a congressional nomination for appointment.

II. Application Requirements

- **Deadline**: To be considered for a nomination to a United States Service Academy, the completed application with ALL supporting materials must be received in Rep. Levin's District office by 5:00 p.m. Saturday, October 31, 2020.
- **Multiple applications:** Because nominations are highly competitive, you are encouraged to apply for nominations with additional offices, including those of President Trump, Vice President Pence, Senator Feinstein, or Senator Harris.
- **Standardized Testing***: A copy of your Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) and/or American College Testing (ACT) scores is required.
 - *Note: The results of the autumn SAT and ACT will arrive too late for consideration in your application.
- Transcript(s): An official high school transcript must be included with your application materials. <u>The transcript must list your senior year courses.</u> Please also provide a transcript for any college work that you have completed.
- Letters of recommendation: Three letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation may come from teachers, guidance counselors, coaches and/or employers. At least one letter must come from a science or math teacher. Letters from family members will not be accepted. All letters must be signed and submitted in sealed envelopes.
- **Service Academy Review Board Interviews.** Each qualified applicant will be interviewed by Rep. Levin's Service Academy Advisory Board in **Fall 2020**. Qualified applicants who submit a completed application by <u>5:00 p.m. Saturday</u>, <u>October 31</u>, <u>2020</u> will be notified of their interview appointment time.

An application is considered complete only if it includes ALL the required items, as specified on the checklist on page #1.

Qualified applicants who submit a completed application by <u>5:00 p.m. Saturday</u>, <u>October 31</u>, <u>2020</u> will be notified of their interview appointment time.

III. Selection of Nominees

In addition to seeking a nomination from Representative Levin, you must contact the Admissions Office at each academy of your choosing to open an admissions file. Following consideration of the applicants, Representative Levin's independent review board will propose slates of candidates for nominations to each academy of your choice. <u>Final decisions on appointments and admission are at</u> the discretion of the service academies.

Because nominations are highly competitive, it is to your advantage to apply to more than one academy.

Rep. Levin urges you to research the opportunities afforded by each of the academies to serve the United States.

Interviews will be conducted in November. We will be happy to accommodate requests for applicants who anticipate difficulties in scheduling.
