## **Pickens County Assistance Programs**

Sunbelt Human Advancement Resources (SHARE) - The community action agency known as Sunbelt Human Advancement Resources provides aid in the region. The organization operates a Community Economic Opportunity Department that administers most of the financial aid and support services. They range from funds for paying utility bills, LIHEAP, medications, and more. Housing assistance can be rental or mortgage assistance, transitional housing from Change, and help in paying for moving costs or security deposits for the formerly homeless. SHARE provides coverage across Greenville, Oconee, Anderson and Pickens County in South Carolina. (864) 269-0700

**United Christian Ministries** - This agency is part of the Good Samaritan Alliance and offers services including emergency financial assistance for clothes, rent assistance, money to pay utilities-including security deposits, heat assistance, fuel oil, and life-sustaining medications. **Salvation Army -** Provides numerous forms of assistance for individuals and families with documented emergency. For example, the applicant may have utility shutoff notice, layoff notice, or a medical emergency. The non-profit agency provides clothing, free food, housing and mortgage payment assistance, rent payment assistance, school uniforms and supplies (accepts and distributes), run an on-site thrift shop, and provide utilities assistance. They offer heating oil, propane gas, however they do not have gasoline for cars. **Urban League of Upstate and Pickens County** – Housing resources, including foreclosure and eviction prevention, are offered along with job training and educational programs. **5 Point Church Food Pantry** is an Easley based church that runs a food pantry. They provide free food for people in an emergency. (864) 850-0580

**Catholic Charities** and regional churches provide social services and guidance to the poor and low income. Direct financial and cash grants are rare, but a possibility. Most of the resources provided come in the form of referrals to other non-profits and government programs. Some of the services can include emergency rental and utility bill assistance, dental care from the Save a Smile program, free food, and more.
