A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to adjust the employment size standard requirements for determining whether a manufacturing concern is a small business concern, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Capturing All Small
5	Businesses Act of 2019".
6	SEC. 2. EMPLOYMENT SIZE STANDARD REQUIREMENTS.
7	(a) In General.—Section 3(a)(2) of the Small Busi-
8	ness Act (15 U.S.C. 632(a)(2)) is amended—
9	(1) in subparagraph (A), by inserting "and sub-
10	ject to the requirements specified under subpara-
11	graph (C)" after "paragraph (1)"; and
12	(2) in subparagraph (C)—
13	(A) by inserting "(including the Adminis-
14	tration when acting pursuant to subparagraph
15	(A))" after "no Federal department or agency;
16	and
17	(B) in clause (ii)(I) by striking "12
18	months" and inserting "24 months".
19	(b) Effective Date.—This Act and the amend-
20	ments made by this Act shall take effect one year after
21	the date of the enactment of this Act.
