A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to ensure the Secretary of Veterans Affairs permits the display of Fallen Soldier Displays in national cemeteries.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fallen Warrior Battle-
- 5 field Cross Memorial Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR FALLEN SOLDIER DISPLAYS
- 7 IN NATIONAL CEMETERIES.
- 8 Section 2403 of title 38, United States Code, is
- 9 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
- 10 section:
- 11 "(d)(1) Subject to standards established by the Sec-
- 12 retary, the Secretary shall permit the display of a Fallen
- 13 Soldier Display in any national cemetery.
- 14 "(2) In this subsection, the term 'Fallen Soldier Dis-
- 15 play' means a memorial monument in honor of fallen
- 16 members of the Armed Forces that may include a replica
- 17 of an inverted rifle, boots, helmets, and identification
- 18 tag.".
