#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "ALS Disability Insur-

- 4 SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF WAITING PERIOD FOR SOCIAL SE-
- 5 CURITY DISABILITY INSURANCE BENEFITS
- 6 FOR DISABLED INDIVIDUALS WITH
- 7 AMYOTROPHIC LATERAL SCLEROSIS (ALS).
- 8 (a) In General.—Section 223(a)(1) of the Social
- 9 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 423(a)(1)) is amended in the
- 10 matter following subparagraph (E) by striking "or (ii)"
- 11 and inserting "(ii) in the case of an individual who has
- 12 been medically determined to have amyotrophic lateral
- 13 sclerosis, for each month beginning with the first month
- 14 during all of which the individual is under a disability and
- 15 in which the individual becomes entitled to such insurance
- 16 benefits, or (iii)".
- 17 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 18 this section shall apply with respect to applications for dis-
- 19 ability insurance benefits filed after the date of the enact-
- 20 ment of this Act.
