I am requesting \$25,000,000 in funding for Connecticut Manufacturing Technology & Innovation Center in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Connecticut Center for Advanced Technology at 222 Pitkin Street, Suite 101, East Hartford CT 06108.

The new "Connecticut Manufacturing Technology & Innovation Center" will be home to CCAT's new headquarters, R&D facilities, and existing programs, providing additional capacity for the organization and the State of Connecticut to expand its research capabilities and scale-up current programming.
