
Chair DeLauro and Ranking Member Granger:

I am requesting \$500,000 in funding for the Victim Impact Project in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is Mothers United Against Violence at 2550 Main Street, Hartford, CT 06120.

Mothers United Against Violence was founded in 2002 by a group dedicated to providing direct support to the underserved families who have been impacted by violence in the Greater Hartford community. MUAV is an advocate for the community and has responded to the emotional and physical needs of crime victims. The Victim Impact project is designed to provide the victim with direct services and support. This program works directly with the Police department providing our families with a support arm as they navigate through the criminal justice system. This program will also identify a legal arm to help our victims identify solutions and to help with legal decisions as they are engaging with the criminal justice system. The program also intends to help to reduce the trauma which individuals living in a underserved community is faced with every day.
