
Chair DeLauro and Ranking Member Granger:

I am requesting \$1,200,000 in funding for the Connecticut Trolley Museum Facility Upgrades & Visitor Enhancements in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Connecticut Electric Railway Association, Inc. dba Connecticut Trolley Museum at 58 North Rd. East Windsor, CT 06088.

The funding would be used to take an 81-year-old cultural and historic asset and to totally transform it into one of New England's great living history museums. To accomplish that goal there are six significant areas that this project will address: Correct site drainage issues and pave parking lots; improve front area grounds; refurbish Visitor Center; maintenance work on railway; and refurbish trolley car storage barn.
